- ___ **Spring Arts & Crafts** **Cost: \$50.00** **Teachers: Allison Sheppard and Pattie Sutton** **Grades: K – 5**
We will be making t-shirts, painting pots, and creating many other bright and colorful art projects to get you in the mood for spring.
- ___ **Minute to Win It** **Cost: \$40.00** **Teachers: Beth Sawyer and Courtney Carpenter** **Grades: 1 – 5**
Do you have the skills needed to win it in a minute? Students will have to use their quick thinking and good hand-eye coordination to complete creative 60-second challenges with different household objects. Games will vary in difficulty and silliness!
- ___ **Gymnastics (*A)** **Cost: \$40.00** **Teachers: Tina Long and Linnea Engel** **Grades: K – 2**
Our students will enjoy rolling, jumping and landing, transferring weight, balancing, and much, much more! They will be able to use the mini trampolines, rope swings, beams, springboards plus so much more! It is a great way to work on fitness while having fun! Please be sure to wear comfortable clothing and sneakers on Mondays.
- ___ **Basketball (*A, *O)** **Cost: \$40.00** **Teacher: Amanda Edmunds** **Grades: 1 – 5**
An introduction to basketball fundamentals. We will focus on dribbling, passing, shooting and defense throughout the course of this class.
- ___ **Fun with Dogs** **Cost: \$ 45.00** **Teacher: Jill Cucaz** **Grades: 3 – 5**
This class will introduce students to basic grooming skills, dog obedience and responsibility of dog ownership. Students will also explore the many ways of having fun with their dog through agility, rally, obedience competition and pet therapy.

Students who are uncomfortable around dogs or have pet-related allergies should not take this class.

Join Drama Kids for our dramatic 4-week acting and improvisation workshop. Students will take part in new dramatic activities that include: mini-scripts, characterizations, scene starters, small plays, speech and movement techniques, and improvisation skills. Above all, we NEVER repeat a lesson or play, our drama classes are fast paced, great fun, and have new activities and lessons each week. The session concludes with a wonderful mini-performance for family and friends.
- ___ **Fun w/ Duct Tape and Rainbow Loom** **Cost \$ 50.00** **Teacher: Mary Beth Lenertz** **Grades: K – 5**
Don't "stick" with the same old uses for duct tape. Join this class, and you will turn taping into an art form! You will learn to make key chains, pencils toppers, stylish headbands, and bows, fashion your very own wallet, and create a tote to carry your projects in. These are just a few of the projects we plan to make! Duct tape will be provided, but feel free to bring your own cool designs. Break out your Rainbow Loom and learn the basics of how to create bracelets, rings and necklaces! Once we have the basics we will learn a few more challenging designs. Get your wheels in gear with our roller skating clinic! Learn the basics of stopping, rolling, balancing, forward skating, and forward cornering with our beginning level. Already a pro? Jump straight into our intermediate level and tackle backwards skating, backwards cornering, edging, and two-foot turns. Skaters may bring their own skates and/or rollerblades or they may use our rental skates at no additional charge. Instruction will take place outdoors, so students must wear long pants, socks, and a jacket. Please bring a snack and water bottle. Get ready to ROLL!!!

While this game doesn't involve flying on broomsticks, Quidditch is a combination of common sports like soccer, dodge ball, and basketball. Each student will be assigned to a different house each week we play (Gryffindor, Slytherin, Hufflepuff, or Ravenclaw). Wizard robes, wands and broomsticks are not necessary, but tennis shoes are required.
- ___ **American Ninja Warriors (*A)** **Cost: \$40.00** **Teachers: Tina Long and Linnea Engel** **Grades: 3 – 5**
This will be an awesome class filled with many competitions and dodging activities that are loved by so many! We will have both partner and groups competitions! Be prepared for a great workout and a lot of fun! Please be sure to wear comfortable clothing and sneakers on Tuesdays.
- ___ **March Madness Math** **Cost: \$ 40.00** **Teachers: Doug Rodgers and Courtney Carpenter** **Grades: 3 – 5**
Students will jump into basketball statistics by filling out brackets and watching basketball games while keeping track of different stats like shooting percentage, free throw percentage, and 3 point percentage. We will start with the ACC tournament as a warm up for the "Big Dance," the NCAA Men's Basketball tournament. Students will compete against each other, staff members, and celebrities to see how their brackets stack up. This is a great application of real world math that involves sports, so if you love basketball, math, and having fun - this is the class for you. There will be prizes for students who have the top 5 brackets! (We will not be playing basketball, but it will be dunk-tastic:)
- ___ **Pom Pom Friends** **Cost: \$ 40.00** **Teacher: Jill Cucaz** **Grades: 2 – 5**
Do you like having fun and doing crafts with pom poms? Then this is the class for you. Make adorable puppies, piglets, chicks, fish and more. Then create a display scene for your new friend. All materials are included.

Where would we be without the tinkerers, inventors and engineers who make our lives easier through their amazing contraptions? These Mad Science classes provide hands-on fun as we build structures, make things twirl, fling and fly through the air, all while understanding and exploring the science behind some of the awesome forces around us.

Students will create a variety of clay projects, completing approximately 4 pieces.

Students will learn the basics of sewing by using both a sewing machine and by hand. Supplies for the class will be included and our goal is to complete 2 projects.

Acrylic on canvas landscape. The students will be able to finish a landscape painting on canvas using acrylic paint- includes the canvas, a brush set w/ pallet and paints to be used.
